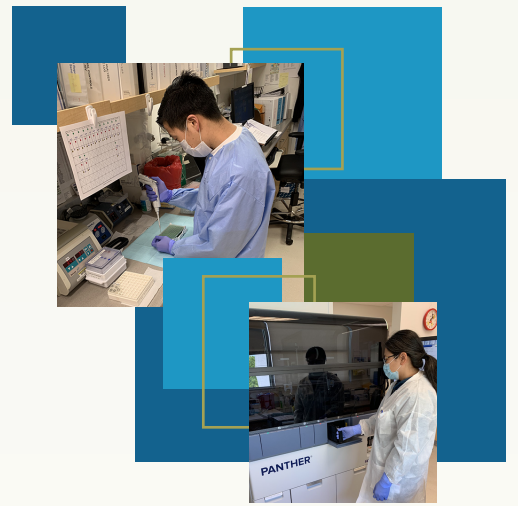


HOW TO GET COVID-19 TESTING



NEED HELP? FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1. Do you have health insurance?

Contact your healthcare provider -- testing policies vary among local insurers. Most will provide tests with a referral from your doctor. Be sure to mention that you work in a nursing home or residential care facility for the elderly.

2. Do you live in Contra Costa County?

Get a fast and convenient COVID-19 test at no cost to you, 7 days a week. Drive-through and walk-in locations available across the county.

Call 1-844-421-0804 to make an appointment. Online registration is available for some sites (Brentwood, Pinole, Walnut Creek) at lhi.care/info

3. Do you live somewhere else?

Check with your local health department about testing options in your community. Most post information about community testing on their web pages.
