



Fewer reported crimes



### THE RIGHTS





### Who is a Victim?

A person who suffers direct or threatened physical, psychological, or financial harm as a result of the commission or attempted commission of a crime or delinquent act

The person's spouse, parents, children, siblings, or guardians

Lawful representative of a crime victim who is deceased, a minor, or physically or psychologically incapacitated

### Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Notification of Rights

### Marsy's Law

 Marsy's Law: Notify victims about Marsy's Law and give them a written copy

#### Penal Code

 Every law enforcement agency investigating a criminal act and every agency prosecuting a criminal act shall.....
 "provide or make available to each victim of the criminal act without charge or cost a "Marsy Rights" card"

> Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)(17); Cal. Pen. Code 679.026(c)(1)

### Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights

**Fairness and Respect** 

### Fairness and Respect

- Treat victims fairly and respectfully, with concern for your privacy
- To be treated with fairness and respect for his or her privacy and dignity, and to be free from intimidation, harassment, and abuse, throughout the criminal or juvenile justice process.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)(1)

### Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights PROTECTION

### Marsy's Law

 To be reasonably protected from the defendant and persons acting on behalf of the defendant

#### Penal Code

### California Secretary of State Office Safe at Home Program

Confidential address program

Offers substitute mailing address to receive first class, certified, and registered mail.

Enrolled participants can use the Safe at Home P.O. Box as their official address.

State and local government agencies are required to accept the Safe at Home address on the participants' identification card; however private companies and the federal government are not. Confidential voter registration

Used by California state, county, and local government agencies when creating or modifying a public record

Department of Motor Vehicles Records Suppression Program Confidential name change petition through the California Superior Court system

Confidential Vehicle Smog
Certificate through the
Bureau of Automotive
Repair

Online privacy protection through the office of the California Attorney General.

### Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Bail and Release

### Bail and Release Conditions

 To have the safety of the victim and the victim's family considered in fixing the amount of bail and release conditions for the defendant.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)(3)

## Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Confidential Information

#### Prevent Disclosure of Confidential Information

• To prevent the disclosure of confidential information or records to the defendant, the defendant's attorney, or any other person acting on behalf of the defendant, which could be used to locate or harass the victim or the victim's family or which disclose confidential communications made in the course of medical or counseling treatment, or which are otherwise privileged or confidential by law.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)(4)


# Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Defense Attorney

### Defense Attorney Contact

 To refuse an interview, deposition, or discovery request by the defendant, the defendant's attorney, or any other person acting on behalf of the defendant, and to set reasonable conditions on the conduct of any such interview to which the victim consents.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)(5)

# Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Speedy Resolution

### Speedy Resolution of Case

 To a speedy trial and a prompt and final conclusion of the case and any related post-judgment proceedings.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)

### Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights

**Input: Pre-Sentence Report** 

### Provide information regarding the Pre-sentence Report

 To provide information to a probation department official conducting a pre-sentence investigation concerning the impact of the offense on the victim and the victim's family and any sentencing recommendations before the sentencing of the defendant.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)




Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Restitution

## Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Restitution

### To Secure Restitution Order

 All persons who suffer losses as a result of criminal activity shall have the right to seek and secure restitution from the persons convicted of the crimes causing the losses they suffer.

Cal. Const., art. I, §28(b)





Typically set at sentencing

No statutory deadline

Cannot be set to zero

May be ordered with amount "TBD"

Court retains jurisdiction "for purposes of imposing or modifying restitution until such time as the losses may be determined"

Cal. Penal Code § 1202.46



#### **Losses Restitution**

**Economic losses** 

Repair or replacement cost for damaged/lost property is covered

No statutory maximum

No dollar maximum for each category

Property loss/damage recoverable

Future medical & mental health

Future lost income

Pain and suffering for PC 288 violations

Other losses

## Financial Assistance when there is no criminal case or conviction

#### **Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB)**

Reimburse up to \$70,000 for:

Funeral and Mental Home Income loss burial health security services expenses Loss of Insurance Insurance Relocation support co-payments co-payments

Crime scene cleanup

Medically necessary equipment

Job retraining



#### **CalVCB- Expenses NOT covered**

Any expenses paid by insurance or another source of reimbursement or coverage Cannot pay for any expense not related to the crime **Damages for pain and suffering Expenses for lost, stolen or damaged** property

#### **Qualifying Crimes**

Requirement- Actual (or threat of) physical injury

Require a death, physical injury, or a threat of physical injury (emotional harm)

For certain crimes, emotional injury alone suffices



Covers victims of crime that occur in California or Californians injured in crimes outside the state

#### **Examples of Qualifying Crimes**

**Online Assault with** Murder **Sexual assault** deadly weapon **Harassment Terrorist** Human **Domestic Vehicular offenses** threats trafficking violence Other crimes leading to **Stalking Elder abuse Hate crimes** actual(or threat of) physical injury



## Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Return of Property

#### Prompt Return of Property

 To the prompt return of property when no longer needed as evidence.

## Marsy's Law: Automatic Rights Parole and Post-Judgement Release

## Safety Considered before Parole and Post Judgement Release Decision

• To have the safety of the victim, the victim's family, and the general public considered before any parole or other post-judgment release decision is made.

## Best Practices for Rights that Have to Be Requested

Should notify both victim advocate AND district attorney

Do so at OUTSET of case

Do so in WRITING

Ensure it is in the case file at DA's Office



#### To Confer with Prosecuting Agency

 To reasonable notice of and to reasonably confer with the prosecuting agency, upon request, regarding, the arrest of the defendant if known by the prosecutor, the charges filed, the determination whether to extradite the defendant, and, upon request, to be notified and informed before any pretrial disposition of the case.

#### Notice of Public Proceedings

 To reasonable notice of all public proceedings, including delinquency proceedings, upon request, at which the defendant and the prosecutor are entitled to be present and of all parole and other post-conviction release proceedings, and to be present at all such proceedings

#### To Be Heard

• To be heard, **upon request**, at <u>any proceeding</u>, including any delinquency proceeding, involving a post-arrest release decision, plea, sentencing, post-conviction release decision, and any proceeding in which a right of the victim is at issue

#### Pre-Sentence Report

 To receive, upon request, the pre-sentence report when available to the defendant, except for those portions made confidential by law.

#### To Be Informed

• To be informed, **upon request**, of the conviction, sentence, place and time of incarceration, or other disposition of the defendant, the scheduled release date of the defendant, and the release of or the escape by the defendant from custody.

#### Parole Proceedings

To be informed of all parole procedure, to participate in the parole process, to provide information to the parole authority to be considered before the parole of the offender, and to be notified, upon request, of the parole or other release of the offender.



#### Standing


 Victim's rights attorney has standing to be in courtroom to represent the best interest of the crime victim

- There to support and advocate for victims' rights


